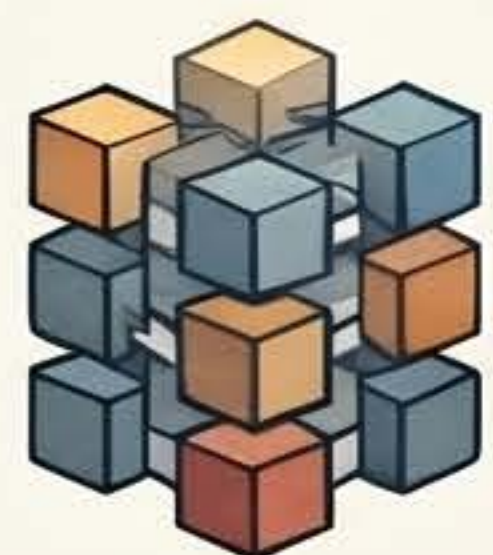


Faith vs. Algorithm: Navigating AI Bias with Biblical Anchors

Medical AI diagnostic rates drop significantly for dark skinned patients due to unrepresentative data.

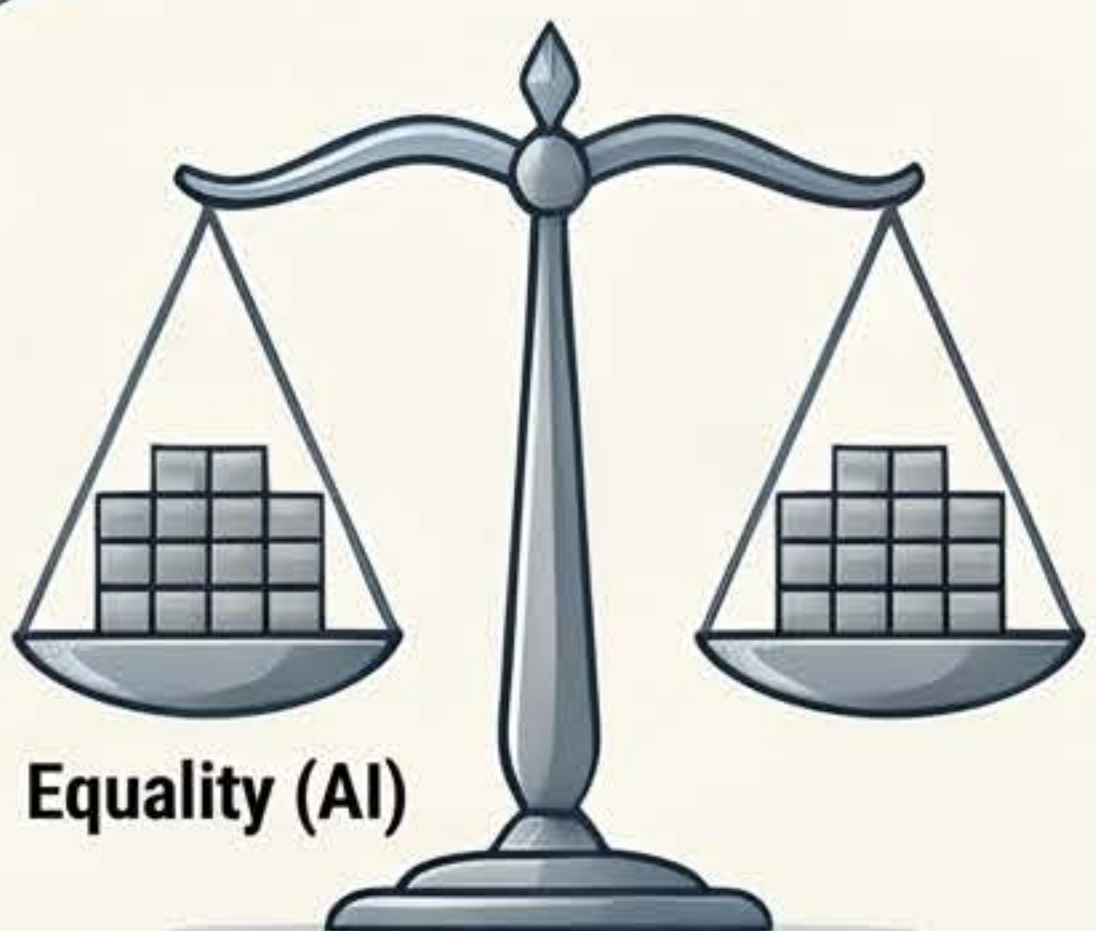
The "Black Box" Accountability Vacuum

The Solution: Theological Anchors



Equality (AI)
