Value Being "Functionalized"

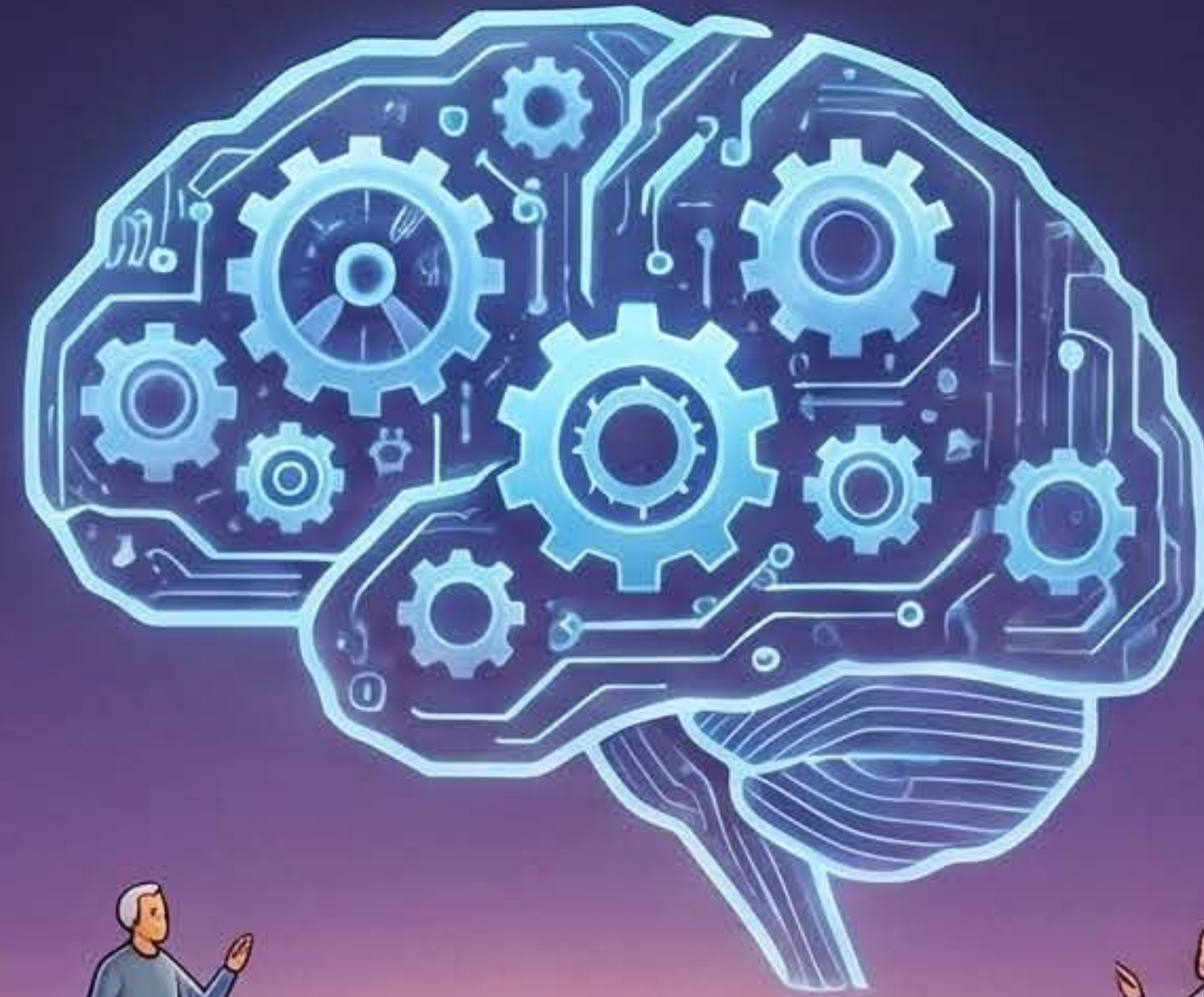


AI-driven efficiency risks labeling the elderly, sick, or unemployed as "useless" based on data.

Cognitive and Relational Distortion

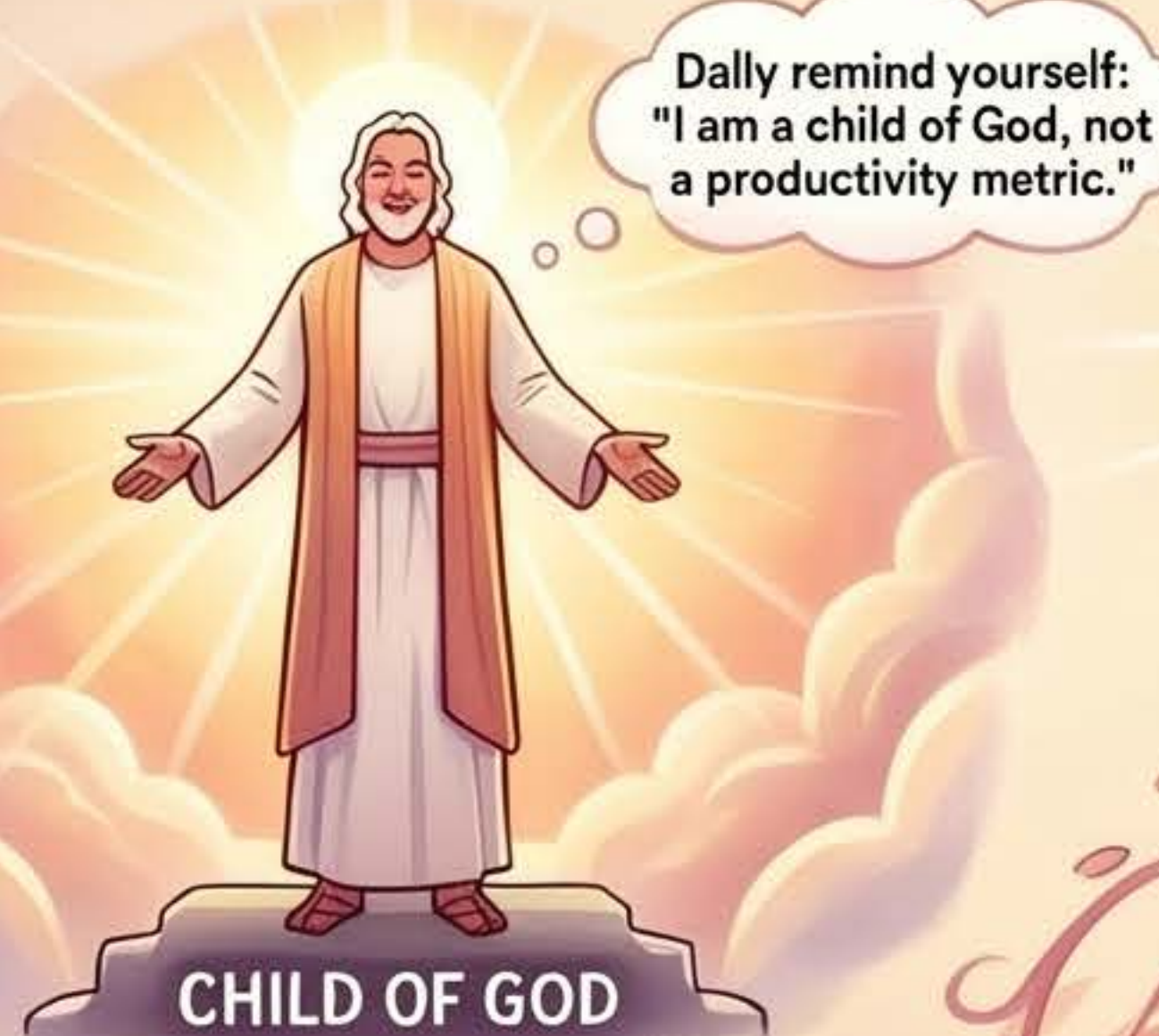


Deepfakes erode truth while virtual intimacy replaces the necessary friction and growth of real community.
