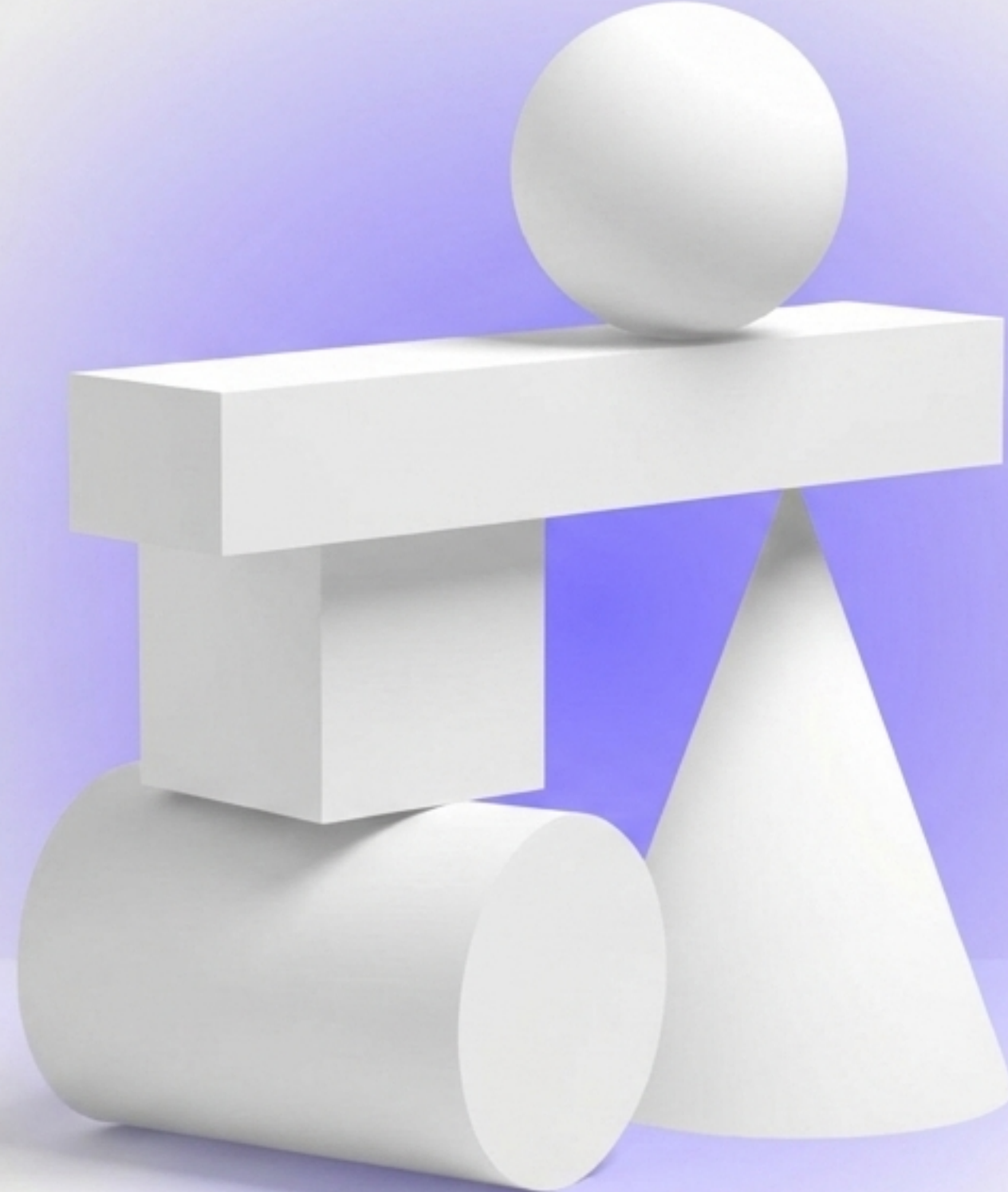


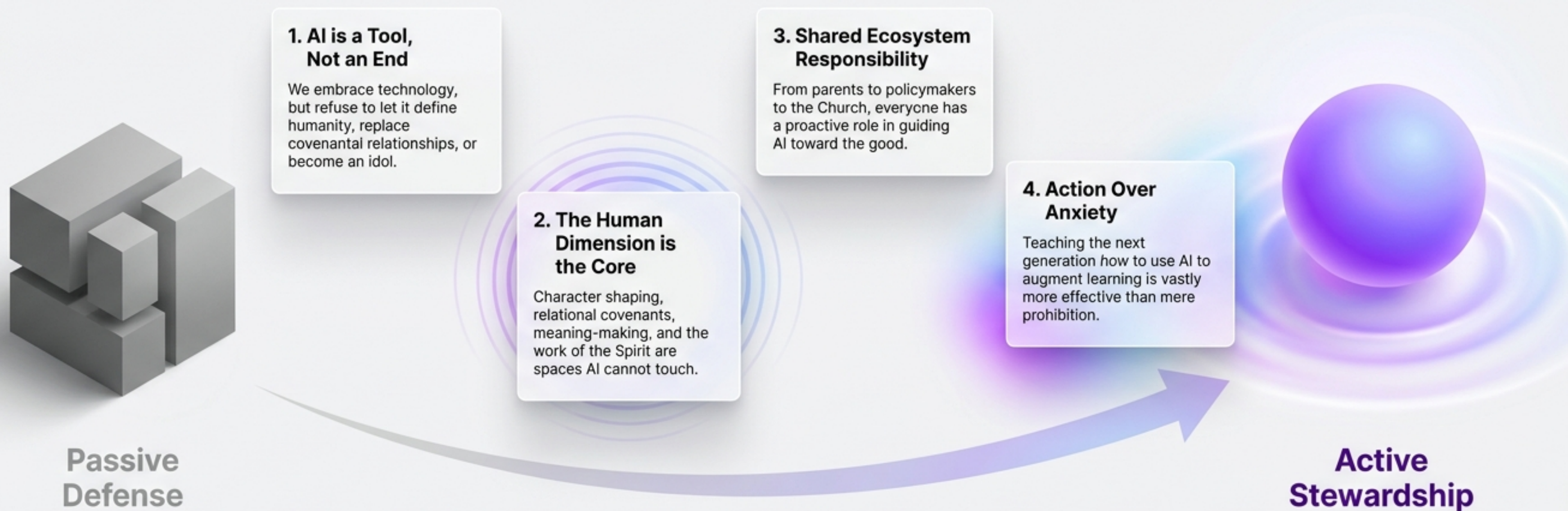

# The Parental Paradigm: Anchor of Truth, Navigator of Love

*In the AI era, parents do not need to be software engineers. They must be two things:*



## The Anchor (Truth)

Grounding a child's value in God, not grades. Establishing the home as a 'Truth Practice Ground' where life is richer than the virtual world.



## The Navigator (Love)

Guiding them through the information flood with active listening, wisdom, and curiosity rather than immediate restriction.

## Three Practical Family Habits

### Digital Sabbaths

Implementing weekly screen-free time to escape algorithmic rhythms.

### Co-Practicing Stewardship

Reviewing an AI app together to ask, 'How do we manage this tool so it doesn't manage us?'

### Modeling Weakness

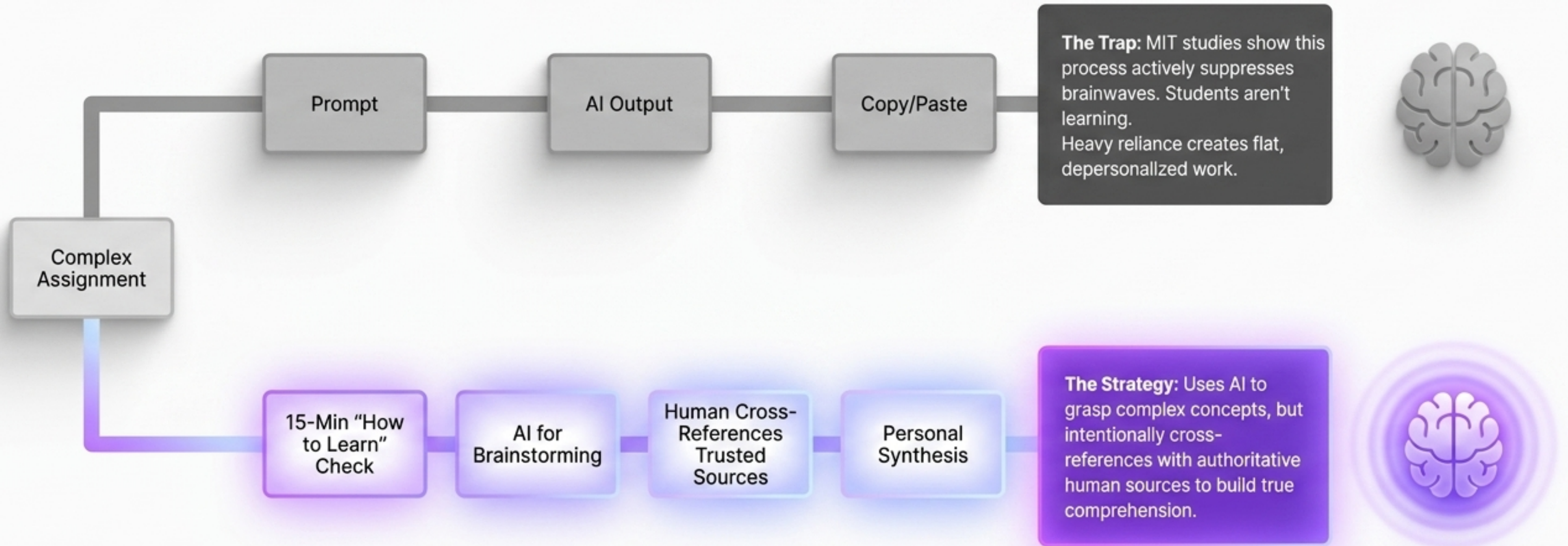
Sharing our own struggles to show the answer to life isn't better tech, but deeper trust (2 Cor 12:9).

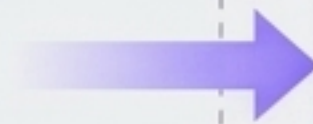
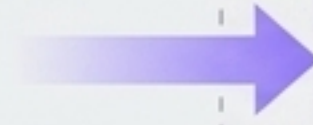

## Ethical Debates:

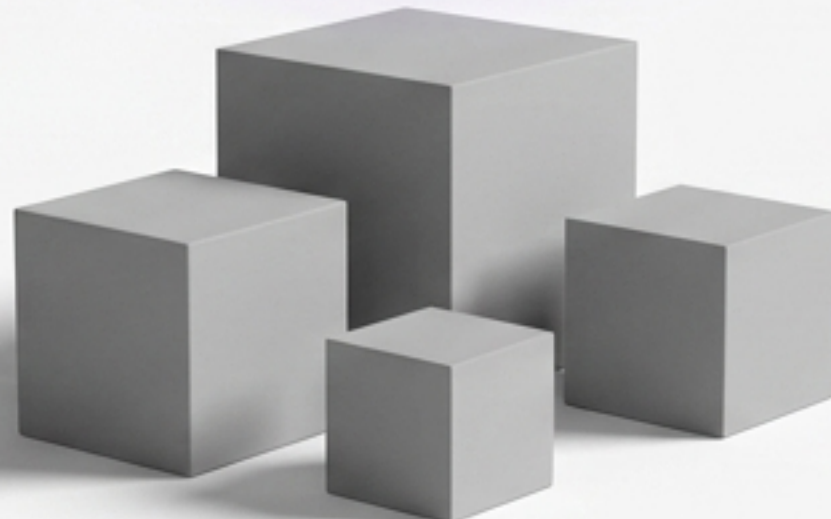
Using the temptation of AI itself as a live discussion on moral choices.

## The 'Wrestling' of Reading:

AI can summarize a book, but only a human can experience the transformative struggle of reading, finding meaning, and remembering the feeling of the text.

- Generating multi-level handouts and tiered practice problems.
- Drafting baseline rubrics and initial quiz questions.
- Providing 24/7 basic Q&A and 'spaced practice' tutoring for students.

# Systemic Responses: The Global Ecosystem



## **Responsible Integration (OECD)**

Focus on personalizing learning while establishing strict governance frameworks to manage data privacy, algorithmic bias, and equitable access.



## **Core Literacy (India - SOAR & NEP)**

Treating AI as a fundamental skill like reading and math. Introducing a 45-hour AI curriculum (Aware, Acquire, Aspire) starting in the 3rd grade.



## **Indigenous Philosophy (Winnipeg, Canada)**

Applying 4 existential questions:  
Where do I come from?  
Where am I going?  
Why am I here?  
Who am I?  
AI can state your job title, but it cannot answer your existence.

# The Church's Mandate: Teleology and Formation

**Core Insight:** If AI can perfectly transmit knowledge and pass exams, what is the actual purpose of education?

## The Theological Reframing

### 1. Redefining Capability

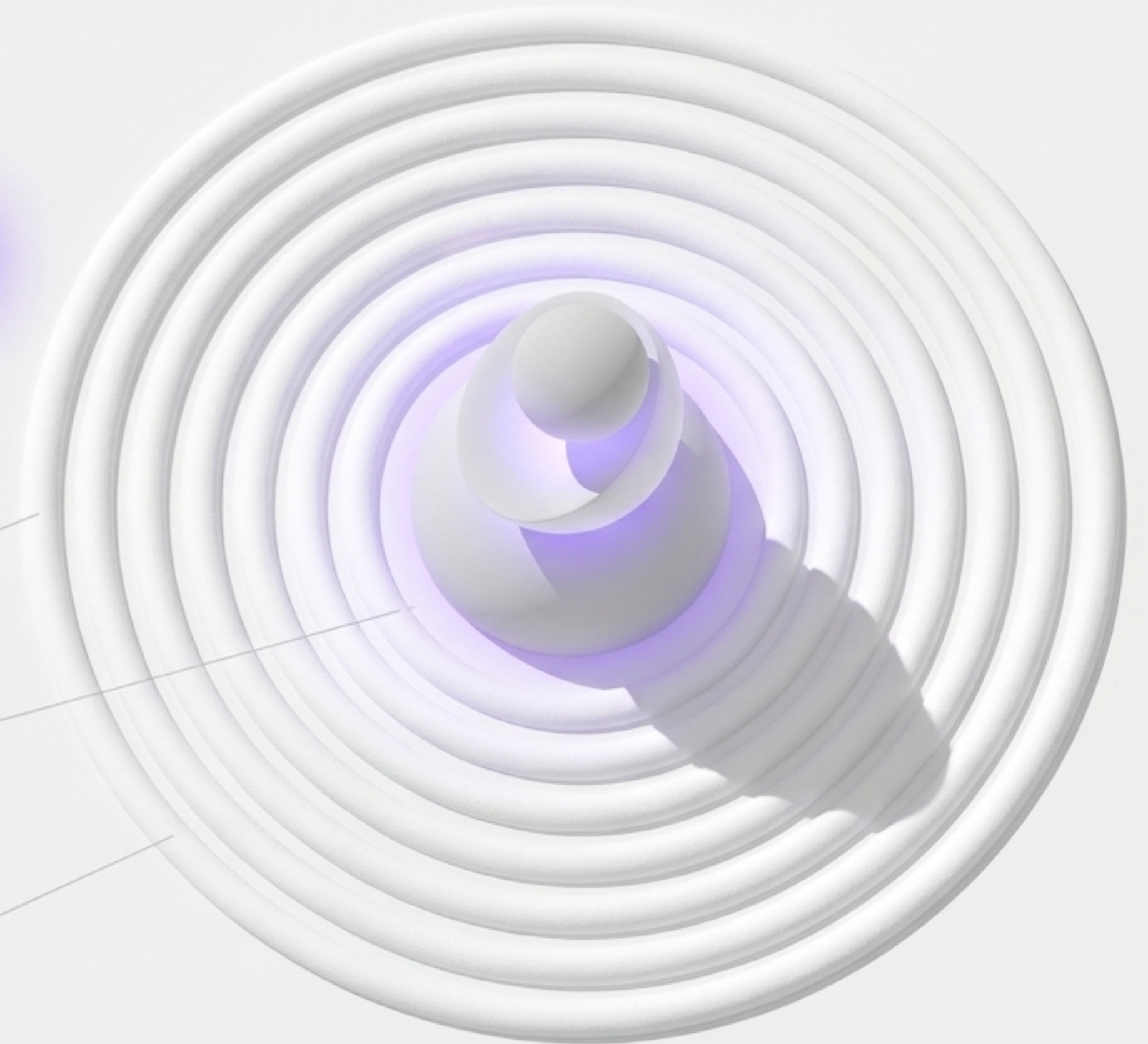
Essays and exams are no longer reliable proxies for capability. We must rethink what we actually want students to do.

### 2. Community Assessment

True knowledge is the intersection of content, character, and craft. The only way to measure this is in real, incarnational community. AI proves we need each other more than ever.

### 3. A Seat at the Table

There is a critical need for biblical perspectives on human dignity within national higher-ed AI councils.



# Synthesis: Salt and Light in the Digital Age

*You are the salt of the earth...

In the AI era, this calling is more urgent than ever. We do not reject technology; we step into the algorithmic flood with discernment, warmth, and testimony.
