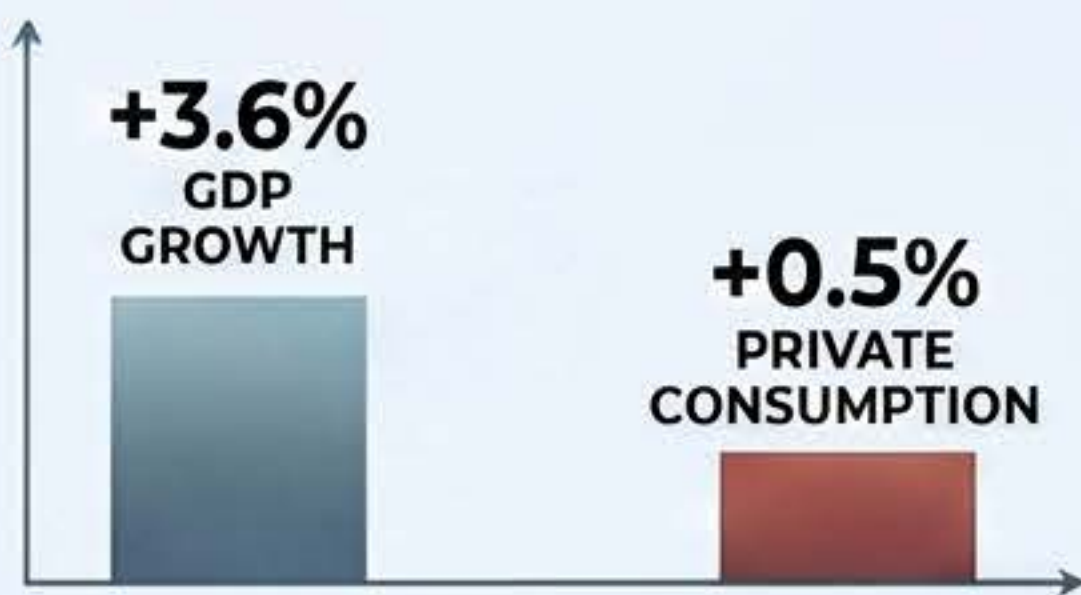

Humans are created in God's image, not as optimizable data to be commodified.



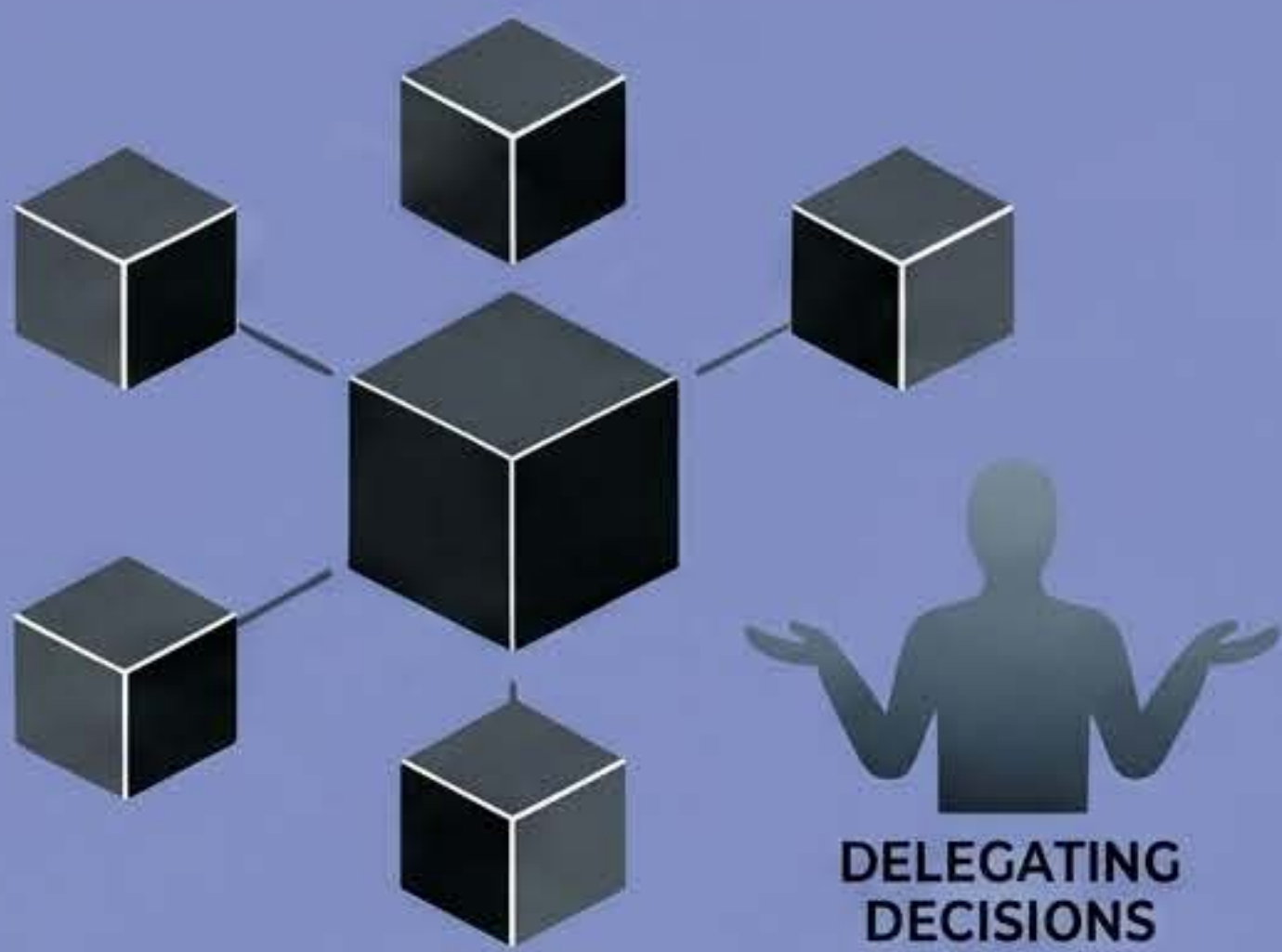
THE EROSION OF LEGAL INTEGRITY

REMOVES PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY

Delegating decisions to black-box algorithms removes the biblical requirement for personal responsibility and oversight.

"HUMAN-IN-THE-LOOP" JUSTICE



KEEP HUMAN JUDGES

Use AI for research, but keep human judges to provide mercy and accountability.
